#### DISCERNING GOD'S CALL

I graduated from the University of New Mexico in 1989. My first "real" job, using my degree in environmental design, was working with the State Historic Preservation Office to complete a field survey of historical architecture in Alamogordo, NM. A year later, I took a similar position as part of a 3-person team surveying coal-mining-related resources in rural West Virginia. I attended First Christian Church in Charleston. One Sunday while sitting comfortably in my pew, I listened intently to Rev.

John Atkinson's sermon about God calling Moses. He said that God might be calling someone in that very room. I thought to myself, "Thank goodness it isn't me!"

Now, after having been ordained 23 years ago, and having clearly heard God's call to serve in congregational ministry with multiple churches in various states, I sometimes chuckle at the innocence of my younger self. We can never fully know what God is up to. God does surprising things all the time! God calls unexpectedly to us, challenging us to step out of our comfort zones - calling us to *trust* in the the Holy Spirit, even when "common sense" might make us hesitate. The theme for Fall Feast this September will be "Putting Feet to Our Faith." During the nine plus years of ministry I've shared with you, I've come to know FCC Casper as a part of the body of Christ that can indeed boldly answer God's call. When I came to the board nearly two years ago with a request from the region to host the next regional assembly, there was a positive response: Yes! So, soon, we will welcome Disciples sisters and brothers from NM-ID-UT-CO and WY to hear our Regional & General Ministers preach in this place we know as God's home. When Dennis Baker approached the board of elders and then the executive board with a proposal to explore calling an associate minister, the response was unanimous - Yes, let's explore what that could look like.

#### ASSOCIATE MINISTER CONVERSATION

So, the process is moving forward. A small group has been formed to help FCC explore and This is not a search committee, but an information gathering team. They are discern God's call. working intently and will report back to the congregation in early October (most likely at a second all-congregation conversation session on Oct. 7). Those on the 'information gathering team' for the discernment process of calling an Associate Minister are: Dennis Baker, Al Singleton, Michelle Elser, Jo Cox, Keith Rouse, Tom Dowler, Cal Decker. They are working intently on two primary areas - 1) What might a job description look like for this position? What key spiritual gifts do we most need in a second staff member? What hopes/dreams do we have for expanding ministry that this person could 2) In conjunction with stewardship, they will look at the church's fiscal lead us towards? responsibility in relation to this position. What invested funds are earmarked for an associate minister which would continue to go unused if we don't take this step? What range of salary packages would be appropriate for this position, depending on the person called? Members of the team have been assigned to contact specific groups within our congregation for feedback as well as to be in conversation with our regional minister and other Disciples of Christ congregations in the region. You are encouraged to **PRAY** for God's leading during this process, to pray for the team members, and to speak with any of them to share your feedback.

How do you "put feet" to your faith? In what ways will FCC Casper answer God's call to step out together in our next era of ministry? May the Holy Spirit guide our discernment and our lives.
