

The Importance of Relationships

One of the questions seminarians are asked while studying theology is, "What is the Church?" Before I was ordained two dozen years ago, I remember answering that question by quoting the children's song, "The church is not a building, the church is not a steeple - the church is the people!" It's a simple summary of a profound truth. We may think about the "church" as being a

beloved, sacred space (such as our spiritual home at 520 CY Ave.) and we talk about "going to church" (meaning *worship* at a specific time) - but at its core, THE CHURCH is the Body of Christ - a group of believers related to one another and united through their faith in God.

My relationship with you is nearing a key milestone - in June, I will have had the privilege of being your Lead Pastor for ten years. It would take some effort to count up a decade's worth of sermons preached, funerals led, hospital calls made or meetings attended. It would be impossible to measure the hours spent in prayer. But far more important than a mathematical accounting is the depth of relationships we've shared. I've celebrated with you the birth of children, graduations, weddings and baptisms. I've grieved with you the death of saints, relationships ending and other deep losses. I've watched in wonder as members of the church have grown closer to God, maturing in faith and developing as leaders. Thank you, Church, for opening your hearts and home to me and Charles.

We are also blessed by faith relationships that stretch far beyond Casper. When our women attend "Renewal," when Mike goes to Men's Retreat or Tom goes to the Fly Fishing & Theology event, when our youth go to summer camp or we work together to host Fall Feast, we are privileged to deepen the web of relationships shared across the Central Rocky Mountain Region. I give thanks for these relationships now especially as our Associate Minister Search Committee prepares to move forward. Recently, I was blessed to spend time on the phone with our Regional Minister, Rev. Joan Bell Haynes updating her on the time and effort already invested in preparing for our search. (Thank you again to Dennis Baker, the information gathering team, the job description team and the elders and board for getting us to the starting line.) Joan and I prayed together on the phone that day - for our congregation's future and for the Search Committee. Take courage friends! We are NOT alone.

Our Disciples connections go even further... Last Saturday, Bob Brite (interim pastor at FCC Cheyenne) led an evangelism workshop for us. Did you know that Paul Hallock was Bob's pastor when he was in high school? Bob's ministry crossed paths with Rev. Frank See after he'd left Casper. We are connected to each other. Before Easter, I received a phone call from the Office of the General Minister & President in Indianapolis. Rev. Lee Hull Moses, chief of staff for Terri Hord Owens, was calling to thank FCC Casper for being **one of the top 100 giving churches** in our denomination. That's because we are a Tithing Church. Long ago, FCC's leadership made the decision - if we're going to ask our members to tithe, to give 10% of their income to God's work, the church should do the same. So, we dedicate 10% of a specific share of our annual budget to support the Disciples Mission Fund. This commitment keeps our congregation's relationship with the broader church intentionally strong. Thank you Church for continuing to honor these important, holy relationships.

Charles and I recently celebrated our anniversary. He is my rock, my life partner, my best friend. I am so blessed by the love we share - yet I know I am truly fortunate to have many life-giving relationships - with family, with life-long friends - and for the past decade with wonderful, dedicated members of FCC Casper. I pray that FCC is a source of strength in *your* life - a place where we can all find and form deep, life-supporting, holy relationships. 21 years of marriage - 10 years of ministry in Casper - how time flies! I am praying this day that you are blessed by a relationship with Jesus Christ, and by human relationships that deepen that Holy connection. - *Pastor Cynthia*



We are following the official "Search and Call" process within our denomination, the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Our Regional Minister will provide support to the search committee as they prayerfully move forward. The "congregational profile" describes who we are as a church. There is still some preparation work ahead before we will be ready to receive names of potential candidates. At that point, we will know that applicants are ordained Disciple clergy who have had a background check done and are in good standing. Seeking a minister includes a great deal of trust - the church must trust that they are following God's leading, the members of the search committee must trust each other (they probably won't always agree or see things from the same perspective, but they are called to work together with mutual respect, trying to listen to one another, to the congregation as a whole, and to the Holy Spirit). It takes time to officially enter the process - and then it can take many months to find the right candidates who are the "best fit" for a specific congregation. Please pray for our search committee and for clergy who are faithfully, prayerfully trying to listen for God's call.
