

Faithfully Following our Ever-Changing God

I have a friend who says, "If you want to hear the Divine One chuckle, just tell God *your* plans." On our life-long faith journeys, it can seem sometimes that just as soon as we think we have life figured out, God calls us to something NEW. God is calling Charles and I to a new adventure in ministry and life.

For a few of you, this will be the first you've heard that I have accepted a new calling from the Lord. Starting in September, I will serve as the next Senior Minister of First Christian Church in Portland, Oregon. I have been so blessed to be the lead pastor of FCC Casper for **ten years** as we have welcomed new families, celebrated the lives of saints, improved the physical condition of this beloved spiritual home, increased hands-on service to those in need and answered God's call to grow together, loving one another in Christ. Today, FCC Casper, is a healthy congregation with a bright future. God will bless the ministry you share here.

I am excited about the move to "FCCPDX" (PDX is the code for Portland's airport and short-hand for the city itself). The congregation has lived through more than their share of challenges but, thanks to a strong interim period, they are ready and excited for a new future. They worship in a beautiful, historic, downtown sanctuary with modern offices & meeting space. Like FCC Casper, the church building is frequently used by multiple community groups and the congregation actively engages in outreach to their community. They have a strong history of excellent music, are supportive of the arts, have the best church library I've ever encountered and welcome a diversity of people to worship. Most importantly, it feels like a *holy* calling to a place and a people where I can fully use my gifts for ministry. Countless hours of prayer, a deep connection in my heart, and numerous little signs along the way confirm that this is the leading of the Holy Spirit. Yet, with all of that said, I will miss the deep friendships formed here (as well as our preschool & Scouts).

I ask you to join with me in praying *daily* for the Search Committee. After receiving my letter of resignation, the Executive Board has officially approved the Search Committee change their focus from seeking an Associate Minister to immediately beginning the search for your next Lead Pastor. Please pray for an Interim Minister to help shepherd the flock of FCC Casper during this 'in-between' time.

Charles and I have already begun packing boxes - not so much to be ready to move at the end of August as to clean out the house a bit so we can get it listed for sale. (If you know of someone wanting to move to the Big Tree neighborhood, send them our way.) Each box I pack offers a time to hold in prayer signs of change - memories, transition, my love for you, my hopes for your future and prayers for FCCPDX. When I shared the news of this new call with clergy colleagues in town, one of them said, "Oh Cyndy, I'm happy-sad!" Just as my own heart is experiencing a mix of emotions, I know the same is true for many of you. Some of you will be sad at our leaving, some will be excited for a new future coming, some may even feel angry or confused or disappointed, fearful, hopeful, relieved or wondering or even all of the above. Be patient with each other. Feel what you need to feel. For members who've been hoping for something to be different at FCC, this is a prime opportunity to engage or re-engage with ministry here. Commit yourself to attending worship regularly and being involved in ministry. For members who've been blessed by my service as your pastor - permit me to say that the absolute *best* tribute you could give to my time in ministry here with you is to **continue** to show up! Continue to be as engaged in ministry as possible and be as supportive of the church as you have been of your pastor.
