•Offer a benediction: May grace and peace be with us all. Amen.

When we all participate in this at home communion service, at our worship times, we are gathering with our faith community across the city. It is a way for us to maintain our ties to each other and to our God as one people. Knowing others are partaking at the same time, knowing others are reading scripture and praying as we are can fill us with hope in this time of uncertainty.



We are committed to the health, safety and well being of our scouts and their families. After careful consideration and out of abundance of caution regarding


