FCC REOPENING GUIDELINES

We are looking forward to **June 7th** when we will be opening the doors for worship. HOWEVER, before that happens the congregation needs to be aware that things will look different and be different and in compliance with the Governor's Orders, the Health Department and the CDC's rules so we can keep all of our members and guests safe.

1. We will be offering two (2) services each Sunday -- 8:15 and 10:10.

Both services will be the same as our usual 10:10 service. Seating will be **limited to 50** people per service. You MUST make a reservation by contacting the church office @ 234-8964 between 10:30-2:30 (MonThurs) or use the church email <u>fcccasper@gmail.com</u> The church office is closed on Fridays so you are asked to plan ahead.

2. How to enter the church.

You will enter the church either through the fellowship hall door or through the elevator door. A deacon will great you at the elevator to take you up to the main floor. **Hand sanitizer and masks will be made available.** If you have your own mask, we encourage you to wear it. If you do not need the elevator, we encourage you to use the Fellowship door.

3. Seating

A deacon will greet you and escort you to your seat. For social distancing reasons we will seat every other row with alternating rows on either side of the center aisle. You will be seated front to back. After the service the deacon will dismiss the congregation from the back of the church to the front. If you are seated towards the front, please just be patient and we will get you out as soon as possible. There will be NO coffee or social hours at this time so as soon as the service is over, we ask you leave the building as quickly as possible again either through the fellowship hall or by the elevator.

4. Communion

Since we are not able to pass the communion trays you will be given an individual communion packet containing a wafer and juice. Also since we are unable to pass the offering plate, we will have a unique way of collecting the offering during the offering time.

5. Notes about the service.

Hymns, scriptures and bible readings will be on the overhead screens up front. There will be no bulletins. Due to the social distancing guidelines we will not have a choir. If you have little ones, the busy bags have also been put away for now.

6. Groups using the church facility.

Our first priority is to restart our communal worship. The reopening team will work on opening our building again for large and small groups once our new way of worshipping is established.

As a reminder please be safe, wear a mask and use the hand sanitizer. You have been missed and we look forward to seeing you on June 7th. You're safety is our main priority. If you have any questions, contact the church office.
