Nominations are also open for the **Eldership**. Elane Burkhalter, Cindy Huckfeldt, Phil Ostrander and Mark Williams will be completing their terms and **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE** for election as an elder this year. The most visible role of elders is serving during worship, by offering prayers at the Lord's Table and by assisting in worship leadership. The elders also take communion to homebound members on a regular basis and serve as leaders and support for our members. They are asked to pray often – for the church, for specific member's needs, and for the world in which we live. The elders meet the first Monday of every month for prayer and study, to review the serving schedule, and to share pastoral concerns from home-bound members

Nominations are also open for the **Diaconate**. Pat Buck, Cal & Monica Decker, Jackie Greenlee, Elaine Singleton & Dylan Stupak are completing their terms and **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE** for election as a deacon this year. The diaconate is a group of people who serve the church. The diaconate prepares and serves communion. They are on a rotating schedule. Sometimes deacons are asked to assist with worship preparation, sanctuary decorations or changing paraments. This is a spiritual journey. Deacons should faithfully attend worship, support the church by time, talent and treasure. Also they serve the annual Thanksgiving dinner (when we can do this again) and are invited to join a commission of their choice and assist with special projects. Please give prayerful thought to this job if you are asked to serve.

CHURCH PROTOCOL CHANGES REGARDING COVID-19 AS OF 10/11/20

With the continued increase in COVID-19 numbers for Natrona County and trying to keep our congregation safe, we will be implementing the following:

- I. All attendees will have their temperature taken before entering the sanctuary. There will be a greeter with a sign in sheet and will also take your temperature before entering.
- 2. EVERYONE is asked to use hand sanitizer before entering and upon leaving the sanctuary.
- 3 We ask everyone to please wear a mask or face covering. Masks and hand sanitizers are available. If you have your own face covering, we encourage you to wear it throughout the entire service, from entering the building to exiting the building.
- 4. **Seating** -capacity of 50 people. For social distancing reasons we will seat every other row with alternating rows on either side of the center aisle. You will be seated front to back. **FIRST SERVICE WILL SIT IN THE PEWS WITH THE GREEN DOTS. SECOND SERVICE WILL SIT IN THE PEWS WITH THE RED DOTS.** There will be NO coffee or social hours at this time so as soon as the service is over, we ask you leave the building as quickly as possible again either through the fellowship hall or by the elevator.
- 5. **Communion.and offering**..We are still using the individual prepackaged communion cups. Offering is still being collected with the butterfly nets.
- 6. Notes about the service. Scriptures and bible readings are still on the overhead screens up front. We will not be singing hymns for a few weeks and will not have a choir until the regional office and other protocols we are following say it is permissible. SPECIAL MUSIC...Until we are able to have a choir, there is a sign up sheet on the bulletin board if you are interested in providing special music during second service.
- If you have little ones, the busy bags have also been put away for now. but the nursery is open if you are comfortable having your kids in the nursery. Children are welcome to sit with their parents too.

As a reminder please be safe, wear a mask and use the hand sanitizer. You have been missed and we look forward to seeing you in church. You're safety is our main priority. If you have any questions, contact the church office. *Thank you*
