

As of this writing I have preached 4 times (twice in 8:15 service and twice in 10:10). I have started to meet many of our church family, staff, and school teachers and administrator as well as get lost in Casper more times than I can count! With head spinning in mind, I would like to lay out what I would like to do in the next three months: 1) preach each Sunday for our two worship services; 2) Start a

Bible Study starting October 5th called "Sermon in the Round" that will meet on Tuesdays at 11 A.M. and close with a sack lunch for all those who wish to stay; 3) Have us all do a "Trunk or Treat" on Sunday October 31st where we will invite all First Christian Church Preschool families as well as the families in our church - no age limit to participate--you will decorate your car or truck trunk or bed and handout candy and treats that you supply. We will begin this at 5 PM and run until 6:30 PM. If anyone has some games we can set up we could play some corn hole or other games in the theme of Halloween. Please no real scary or gory costumes. You probably noticed that we have something in the newsletter about it and a sign up sheet on the bulletin board as well. 4) Visit our church family and get to know you on a personal basis; 5) Have an Elder's Retreat sometime in the beginning of We will share a time of teaching about the role of the elder in our congregation, as well talk about what we will do as elders in the coming months; 6) Faith Promise is unanticipated income that God blesses you with. All money collected for Faith Promise goes to mission and outreach. We will have a Faith Promise Sunday, a date to be determined, where you will just write down your amount on a card, no name, and put it in the offering plate.






