SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Funding applies to undergraduate work only (except for the ministry)
- Must complete a full-time schedule MINIMUM OF 12 HOURS
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Maximum numbers of semesters will be 4 for an Associates Degree and 8 for a Bachelor's Degree. If major requires more than 120, students may petition Wills, Trusts, Memorial & Scholarships for consideration of an extension.
- Must be an active participating member of FCC Casper, WY.
