

Purpose to approve the 2023 Budget, Board, Elders, Diaconate and approve the proposed Bylaw change & recommendations of the Mission Commission for Faith Promise Funds usage.



In the next few weeks we will take a journey in Advent as we anticipate and later celebrate the coming of Jesus into the world. This is a time when people allow the sacred to trickle into the secular. We see it in public places all the time - bell ringers, opportunities for giving and receiving all over the place. Our church activities and celebrations will find many, who have little to no church involvement interested in church

this time of year. It may be that they come out of curiosity or nostalgia of their pasts. It makes no difference why they are interested, just that they are present to hear about Jesus. We can give them this opportunity by inviting our friends, neighbors and family to our church in this season of anticipation and wonder! On Sunday, December 25th we will only have one service that will be celebrated at 10:10 AM and we will sing Christmas carols, hear the reading of the Christmas Story from the Gospel of Luke and celebrate communion. The church celebrates this time of Advent and Christmas every year. It is a story that we know very well. But not everyone is familiar with Jesus' story. Please share this story through word and deed and invitation. It is a great way to introduce people to our Lord and to our church community. The good news in this season of anticipation is - the story is not finished. God is still writing it and we are participating in the creative story of God. And as participants, we get to create new and exciting twists and turns that all lead to Jesus. Come celebrate in the Story of Jesus in this season of Advent and Christmas. Touch a life. Have your heart touched by the author of our story. Happy New Year - Advent kicks off our Church calendar as Christians. See you in this wonderful season of Hope, Joy, Peace and Love.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THIS PROPOSED CHANGE TO BYLAWS OF FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE CONGREGATION AT THE CONGREGATIONAL MEETING ON

December 4, 2022

ARTICLE 8 – ELDERS, DIACONATE, AND HONORARY MEMBERS **SECTION 8.1** – COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD OF ELDERS AND DIACONATE **SUBSECTION** 8.1.1

CURRENTLY READS: The Board of Elders shall consist of sixteen elected members, being both men and women.

CHANGE TO READ: The Board of Elders shall consist of both men and women, with a number sufficient to meet the needs of the congregation.

REASON FOR CHANGE; This bylaw was written September 1980 when the congregation was quite large. Our congregation has gradually declined, therefore making it very hard to fill the currently required number of 16 for the eldership. By eliminating the designated number of 16 it allows flexibility to increase/decrease the number as needed.
