Dear Church Family,

As of this writing I have preached 108 times (twice a Sunday).

I have been installed by our Regional Minister as your "new" pastor while celebrating my 1 year anniversary as same. A BIG THANK YOU to Doug Goodwin for bring us the Word and for everyone else who participated in this great event. Teresa and I have most recently remodeled our home kitchen. We also celebrated the announcement of a new grand baby to be born in February. We have also just gotten back from the birthday party of our oldest granddaughter and our daughter. As of this writing it is the goal of the Board (Elders and Personnel) to review me over this past year but more importantly to create goals moving forward. A short list of those goals are:

- To lead a Spiritual Assessment program with leaders of the congregation
- Have a consultant come in and help leadership with Visioning and goal setting for the congregation with leadership and interested congregants attending
- For me to attend a Transformation Workshop with our Regional pastors
- Theology and Fishing Retreat
- Continue to be a chaplain at WMC
- Start a "Cookie Call" ministry of visitation with interested people visiting homebound members, members and visitors

OCTOBER 2022

I hope everyone is having a good start to their fall and enjoying their favorite fall flavors and traditions. Here are some questions that have been asked and I will try and answer them as best as I can.

WHEN WILL WE BE UNLOCKING THE CHURCH? If I had a crystal ball I could tell you but since I don't I can tell you it won't be happening soon. We have had several instances where we have had inebriated people try to get into the building or get into the building and we have had to ask them to leave. For the safety of all staff (secretary, business manager & pastor) we are going to keep the building locked. If you need into the building, you come to the elevator door and ring the doorbell. The staff can see who you are and then let you in. If you are with a group, you can get a key from Kathy and then you may unlock the door for entrance if you or someone in your group is close to the door. When your group is ready to meet, unlock the door while you meet and then return the key to Kathy. Please do not leave the door unlocked unattended or propped open. We appreciate your cooperation on helping to keep the staff and all the people in the building safe.

WHY ARE WE DOING SO MANY SECURITY PROCEDURES? Well to start with we have a pre-school and we need to have safety protocols in place to operate this pre-school within state standards. Therefore, we must make sure that there are only monitored doors for access into the church as well as the pre-school area. We have installed security cameras so that we can record activity both inside and outside of the building. If there is an incident, we can hopefully provide footage to the proper authorities for their use. We have a check-in procedure for parents bringing the children to pre-school as well as picking them up. This includes who can drop off and pick up. We have an app that parents can use so that the school can be aware of a safety concern or any changes that the parents may need to make in who is dropping off or picking up the child.

The church had 5 people attend church safety training here in Casper to understand how we can keep our congregation safe and mitigate safety concerns. We are currently reviewing these recommendations to see which ones are applicable and doable. As this progresses, we will keep you informed.

WHEN WILL WE RETURN TO COMMUNION TRAYS? Quite honestly, I don't know if we will ever return to using and passing the communion trays. Our members have said how much they miss helping each other and sharing communion with someone in the same pew. While returning to the old ways gives us that good feeling it is not the healthiest way of doing things. Not even counting COVID, passing communion trays allows flu, colds, and other medical issues to be passed from person to person more readily. Again, one of the main priorities of this church is to keep our church healthy and a safe place to worship. We are not out of the weeds yet with COVID and cold & flu season will definitely be on us very soon.


Dear First Church Congregation and staff,
