## Dear Church Family,

As you know, I am preaching a sermon series on the Lord's Prayer that began in January and will be wrapped up sometime in early March. In this journey we have pondered the questions that this template prayer offers us. I say template because in it Jesus talks about the intimacy of our papa God. He talks about bringing the peace and rightness of heaven here on earth. He speaks of our struggles to make ends meet. He also talks about how we suffer and struggle in life from outside sources that work to destroy us and those we love. But that God can overcome those forces and lead us towards God's glorious future for us, His people. I find hope in this powerful prayer. It is not a prescription - do this and that will happen. It is not magic - say these words three times fast or slow and you will get whatever you wish. It is relationship - talking, listening, learning, loving. My hope in this month that contains Valentine's Day is that we lean into God's love in such a way that it becomes our light that others may find warmth through. Valentine's Day falls on Wednesday the 14th this year. That date is also the beginning of Lent and we will celebrate Ash Wednesday at the church from 8 AM to 10 AM, I will be in the sanctuary and will be offering a devotion from our Lenten Devotional book and a prayer and if you so wish, ashes. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of a remembrance of the 40 days that Jesus was tempted in the wilderness (excluding Sundays). Often people forgo something in this season. You may also take something on - a devotional time in the morning, evening or another time in your day; do some service for another through a food pantry, or a random act of kindness. But honor those days and see what insights God gives you into this life we live for God and with others.

During this time we will have a couple other speakers who will grace our presence in February: Dennis Baker and our Interim Regional Minister, Reverend Dale Matherly. It is exciting to hear from others about their relationship with the God of creation and hear their hearts. I will be out of town on February 11th (when Dennis preaches) for our youngest granddaughters 1st Birthday. She won't remember my presence but that doesn't matter, honoring life does not have to be remembered as much as it has to be done. In this season of winter, do some honoring of others and in so doing make Jesus smile.


