

### FCC CASPER CALL



Dear Church Family—-Over the past few months we have embarked on a season of change. We have seen Spring starting to give way to Summer. Through this transition we have seen dry hot weather, cold snowy weather, some hail, and even rain. We have witnessed and experienced change - grass became green, trees, and flowers burst

forth leaves. The robins arrived and sang the song of change. All things are new in this season of transformation. But what does it mean to transform? Just as Spring means school is winding down and proms are experienced, recitals and programs at school take place, the transformation to summer means no more teachers, no more homework, and for teachers no more students and no more assignments to create and grade. But what else transforms from Spring to Summer. Well, we have time to vacation and enjoy God's creation with that time. But what transforms as the church, in our spiritual life?

# Transformed means: A life increasingly marked by humility, integrity, and love.

- You don't need the spotlight because your joy is found in obedience.
- You begin to live more from *identity in Christ* than *approval from others*.
- You act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly—not because it's trendy, but because it's true.

How often in life do we seem to live in the spotlight? At school it is about performance of grades through tests and quizzes and events and meets and games and social settings with friends and family. At work we are performance based on our outcomes at our jobs - and what worse is that we are often judged by said outcomes at both school and work. But what does it mean to practice our faith as followers of Jesus at school, work and in our social lives? Transformation means that our motivation shifts. The spotlight moves from us to Jesus. Away from what people think to what pleases God, from how does this look to who will be blessed?

We are walking into a season of change in our church as we moved from a solo pastorate (me as Lead Minister) to an Associate Minister. Rhonda Padilla will arrive at the end of June and begin officially on July, 1, 2025. How will we bless her and be blessed by her ministry among us? Well that ministry will be seen in how we authentically practice our living out Jesus. In the coming days we will learn how to interact with each other and find joy in our faith practices. We will see what our identity in Christ is more than our approval from others because we will act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with our God. Not because it is that Micah 6:8 verse that we have as our church's vision statement in some trendy fashionable type statement, but because it is true. My prayer for us is that this season of change is not just another transition but a transformation where our faith is deepened and that deepening of our faith is seen in how we treat one another, others and how we pray, give, live as it flows from who we are trying to impress towards who we are becoming because we strive daily to change more and more into the image of Jesus.
