

Dear Church Family,

What does Spring mean to you? Is it the budding of the trees and the beginning of green sprouting on the branches? It is the daffodils in all their yellow glory? Is it an Easter Egg Hunt and all the children running to get those precious eggs? How about the shift in the weather and the coming of warmer days? What defines Spring for you? With all those

above questions to ponder —

I would like to make some observations about this year as we have just seen over a third of it pass by us: We have had some great growth in the church with several couples, individuals and a families either join the church or attend on a regular basis. We have had a great Easter celebration with our Easter Egg Hunt as well as our Easter Sunday Services. We are a blessed people. As many of you know, our stainless windows are in disrepair and are in need of restoration. In the past we have entered into Faith Promise with a Purpose fund drive for the beautification of our Sanctuary and hallways and entries. We have raised over \$40,000 last year. This year for our windows we have another Faith Promise opportunity and our goal is to raise \$50,000. We are calling the campaign "Let the Light Shine: Restoring Beauty, Reflecting Grace" and we hope you are able to participate.

The big announcement for this May Newsletter is that we have interviewed a candidate, Rhonda Padilla, for our Associate Minister position. We were sent Rhonda's Ministerial Profile through our denominations Search and Call office and our Regional Office. After talking with a couple others it was determined by the Search Committee to interview Rhonda. The committee did that and unanimously asked her to come and preach on Palm Sunday, April 13, 2025. Rhonda did a great job preaching, singing and sharing her vision for the position as well as our church moving forward. The elders met on April 14th prior to the called Board Meeting and unanimously endorsed her to the Board for a Board vote. The Board met that same night and unanimously voted to present Rhonda to the congregation for a vote for the Associate Minister position and that congregational meeting was April 27, 2025 at 9:15 AM. The congregation has voted to extend a call to Rhonda and in the next week we will write a "Letter of Call" that is like an employment contract, her start date being July 1, 2025. We are excited to enter into this new era of ministry and I ask that you pray for Rhonda as she is guided by God in her next steps of ministry with us and pray for us as a church as we embrace Rhonda as our new Associate Minister.

And in this season of honoring our Mothers, may we celebrate, honor and remember our mothers both living and those who have entered into their heavenly reward! Happy Mother's Day!!!

May you see May flowers this Spring and may the God of grace and mercy be with you.


Christian Education will present our 2nd graders going into 3rd grade with their Bible from the church on Mother's Day, May 11th at the 10:10 worship service.
