Your Mission Commission works hard to bring outreach opportunities before the congregation. We had a wonderful blanket tying day on October 18. A group from LDS, as young as 7 years old, joined FCC volunteers and put together 10 blankets. On the same day, the LDS group packed lunches and helped Debbie give them out at the Methodist Church. The youngsters were excited to be involved and felt they were doing something good for our community with blankets and sack lunches.



The Commission has thoughtfully considered where we can help most effectively for people in need. We will be adding another agency to our quarterly outreach giving in 2026, making six groups that we help locally and globally; Interfaith of Natrona County, Week of Compassion, The Navigators (missionary training), Maranatha Children's ministries in Haiti, Sleep in Heavenly Peace, and the Wyoming Food Bank. Our **Fifth Sunday Special Offerings** have been successful and we will continue with the Sandwich Ministry, Blanket Ministry, and serving a meal at the Wyoming Rescue Mission.

Our final **Fifth Sunday Special Offering** in November will involve cash contributions for the school lunch program for under-served students in Casper's high schools. There are many high school students who have no means of paying for their lunches and we want to help! This will be a joint effort with the Disciples Women's Ministry.
