

OUR GOALS...



The goal of our Preschool is to provide a nurturing Christian atmosphere for children ages 2 1/2 - 5 years of age.

The preschool classes provide developmental, age appropriate activities in a non academic settings.

Positive self growth is the major focus at all levels. Exposing students to the community as a whole is a special feature of our school. To achieve this objective, field trips are planned where the children learn from the community and also give to the community in return. To facilitate this, parental involvement is encouraged and expected! Without parental reinforcement, much of our teaching/learning is ineffective or lost! We need parents to be an active partner in our school.

Gross motor movement is an important facet of our program, both in the classroom and developed through independent outdoor play. Unless weather is extremely inclement, all children are expected to go outside and have appropriate attire.

Children participate in Music two times a week and Spanish once a week. These special classes enhance our weekly themes. The three and four year old classes perform for their families and friends in several programs.

PLAYGROUP GOALS

As an introduction to preschool, Playgroup strives to increase children's skill levels in the following areas:

Social - adjusting to daily routine, learning to share/play with others

Self Help - being responsible for belongings, using the bathroom, cleaning up

Gross Motor - running, hopping, skipping, outdoor play

Fine Motor - building blocks, stringing, using crayons/paints

Cognitive - knowing personal information and beginning problem solving



THREE/FOUR YEAR OLD GOALS

To develop self confidence which in turn allows the child to reach out to others in kindness, leadership and problem solving.

To develop an independent attitude to aid the child in becoming more self reliant.

Goals are to be attained by active participation in social, music, art and outdoor activities.



PRE-KINDERGARTEN GOALS

To be able to care for oneself and possessions with minimal teacher assistance. Be able to share and play cooperatively. Learn to sit and complete a ten to fifteen minute task, sometimes independently. Be able to wait in line and to go into the community with appropriate behavior. We attempt to address all the kindergarten readiness skills as outlined by the Natrona County School District. The areas of development are language arts, science, math, pre-reading, art, music, Spanish and outdoor exploration.
